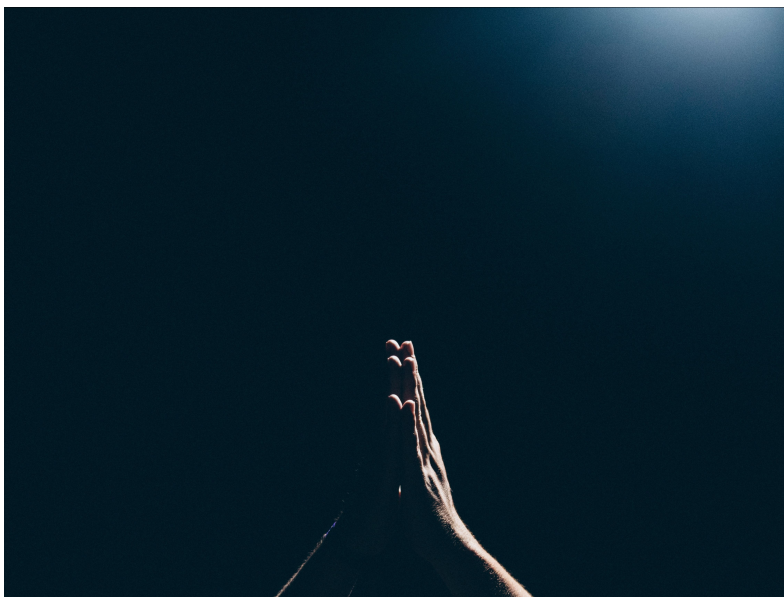

Indiana kicks off 2020 evangelism training



On January 24-27 the *It Is Written (IIW)* Training Weekend was held at the Glendale Church in Indianapolis. 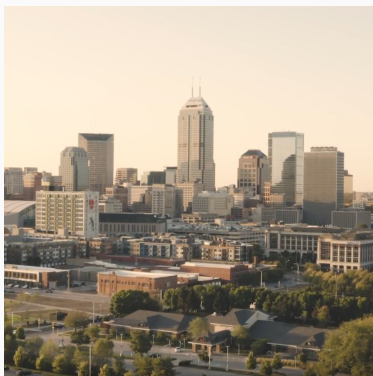

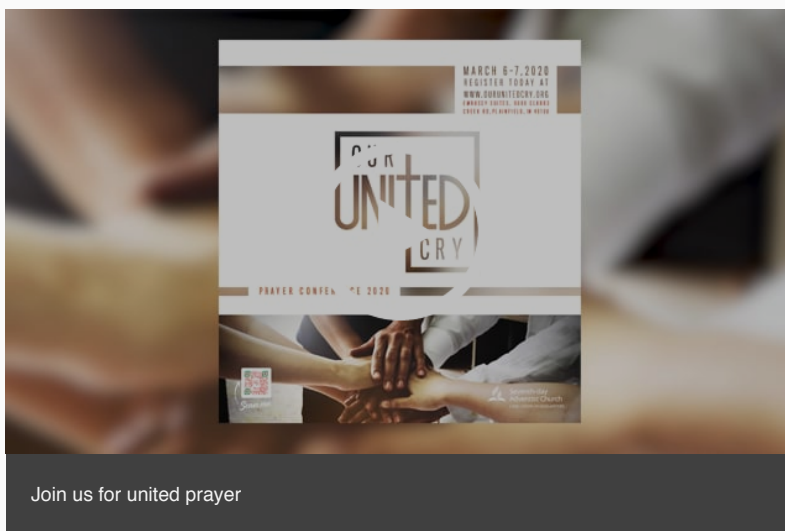

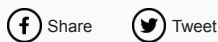
