





"Dynamic evangelists T. Marshall Kelly (left) and E. E. Cleveland (right) are pictured here exiting Pioneer Memorial Church after leading a meeting during the Spring Week of Prayer at Andrews University, March 31 to April 6, 1968. Kelly and Cleveland jointly carried out the evangelistic series. When news of Dr. Martin Luther King's assassination in Memphis on April 4 reached campus, Cleveland recognized what the community would need. He held an impromptu memorial service that Friday afternoon, leading Andrews University in mourning as well as celebration of Dr. King's life."
