Delegates Elect Michigan Conference Leadership

The 34th constituency session of the Michigan Conference of Seventh-day Adventists convened on Sunday, September 24 at the Cedar Lake Seventh-day Adventist Church.

Jim Micheff (center) was reelected to serve as president, a position he has held since Jan. 29, 2018, when he was elected by the Michigan Conference executive committee to succeed Jay Gallimore, who retired. Justin Ringstaff (left) was reelected to serve as the executive secretary, a position he has held since Feb. 24, 2018, when the executive committee elected him to succeed Micheff, shortly after he transitioned to the office of the president. Michael Bernard (right) was reelected to serve as treasurer, and he has served in that capacity since the last constituency held Sept. 30, 2018.




Roger Dudley, Research Pioneer, Passes to His Rest

Roger L. Dudley, who for 40 years conducted groundbreaking human-subject research in the Seventh-day Adventist Church, passed away on September 15, 2023, in Centerville, Ohio. He was 92.

One seminal study Dudley oversaw followed a sample of young people from Adventist families from 15 or 16 years of age until they turned 25 or 26, which led to the discovery that about half were no longer regularly participating in an Adventist congregation, although a larger proportion still identified themselves as Adventist.
