Advent Prayer Center opens in Berrien Springs



On Sept. 9, 2019, a small crowd gathered in the newly-built Advent Prayer Center on the campus of Andrews University for a ribbon cutting ceremony. The concept for the Advent Prayer Center began in 2007, when a Korean prayer ministry dreamed about finding a permanent building. After exploring this idea in Southern California, New Jersey and Arkansas, the group came to Berrien Springs in 2012 to work with the Advent Discipleship Center at the Fil-Am Church. 


